TURKEY







years old.

Çatalhüyük farmers grew little but a wide variety of crops. They grew, ate and traded Wheat and barley. They also grew peas, strawberries, and nuts. Also, this old settlement is on the UNESCO World heritage list. Agriculture, which started 9 thousand years ago in this region, still continues today.

Hearing this, the magic bus and its friends were very impressed and hungry at the end of this adventurous story. They ate Etliekmek, the most delicious and most delicious dish of Konya. The farmer has prepared a delicious Etliekmek for them with the cow meat and the vegetables he grows himself. And they went to visit the beautiful places of Konya. For example, they visited Kilistra, Mevlana's Tomb, Akşehir Lake and Sille.

The Colosseum is an iconic monument with the largest amphitheater ever built that the whole world Knows. It is also called the Flavian Ampitheater and it is situated in the center of Rome. Built under the Flavian Dynasty, its construction started in 72 AD and was completed in 80 AD. Built in concrete and sand, the Colosseum could hold up to 80,000 people, though it usually held 65,000.



Spectators could come to watch gladiator contests and other public show, such as simulated sea wars with props, public executions and mythological dramas. It wasn't until the medieval era that the building was converted and used as a housing facility, a Christian shrine and a fortress

Italia was also very curious to meet chef Antonio who cooked many good typical Italian dishes: spaghetti, lasagna,pizza and Tiramisu'of course.


